Winter Island Exploration

Dive into Salem Sound with a split program: tidepool exploration on land and a boat trip offshore. Larger groups rotate through an additional water quality station.

Ages: All ages (elementary through high school) — activities can be scaled.

Key Science Topics: Intertidal Ecology, Marine Biodiversity, Water Quality

How It Works:

The base package (\$1500) covers most groups of 25–50 students, with two educator-led stations and a one-hour boat cruise at Winter Island.

For larger groups, we add an extra staff-led station for every ~25 additional students (\$250 each).

Boat cruises run in one-hour sessions; extra time or additional groups can be added for \$450/hour.

Programs are designed as school day experiences (9:30–1:30) so students have time to explore, learn, and enjoy lunch.

Schools may also book a boat-only program (\$700), or request a custom field trip at a site near you.

Transformations of Sand & Sea

Students explore how coastlines are shaped by natural forces at Forest River Park. Hands-on stations may include erosion demos, beach profiling, or shoreline organism surveys.

Ages: Best for upper elementary through middle school (Grades 3–8) — younger groups may need more support.

Key Science Topics: Erosion & Deposition, Coastal Habitats, Human Impacts



Salt Marsh Study

Students wade into the marsh to test water quality, survey plants and animals, and explore the role of wetlands in protecting our coasts.

Ages: All ages (elementary through high school) — especially engaging for middle school science.

Key Science Topics: Wetland Ecology, Adaptations, Human Impacts
