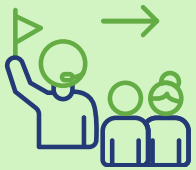


Tidepooling

Explore the tidepools in the intertidal zone! Learn about the different species that inhabit the area as well as identifying which animals are invasive or native.

Venture out into the Salem Sound with Mahi crusies. During your voyage, a lobster trap will be pulled onto the boat and an underwater camera will be dropped to the bottom to inspect what lives below the waves.

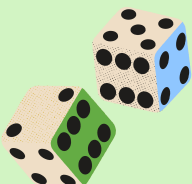


Winter Island History Tour
